

When Jesus Got Up

Luke 24:1-10

I. His Resurrection gave hope to the hopeless.

“Now on the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they, and certain other women with them, came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared.”
(Luke 24:1 NKJV)

“He is not here, but is risen! Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee, saying, ‘The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again. And they remembered His words.’” (Luke 24:6-8 NKJV)

“But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.” (Romans 8:25 NKJV)

“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.” (1 Peter 1:3 NKJV)

- Because of Jesus’ death and resurrection there is always hope!

II. His resurrection was confirmation of the Word.

“And they remembered His words.” (Luke 24:8 NKJV)

“For He taught His disciples and said to them, ‘The Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of men, and they will kill Him. And after He is killed, He will rise the third day.’ But they did not understand this saying, and were afraid to ask Him.” (Mark 9:31-32 NKJV)

“Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.”
(Hebrews 10:23 NKJV)

“Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.” (Mark 13:31 NKJV)

- We can trust the word of God!

III. His resurrection demonstrated almighty power!

“But they found the stone rolled away from the tomb. Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.”
(Luke 24:2-3 NKJV)

“These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.” (John 16:33 NKJV)

“No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father.”
(John 10:18 NKJV)

“O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory? The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”
(1 Corinthians 15:55-57 NKJV)

- There are no stones blocking you that God’s almighty power can’t move!
