

Moma, Just Keep on Believing

2 Timothy 1:1-15

I. Moma understood that this is a faith journey.

“But without faith *it is impossible to please Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.”

(Hebrews 11:6 NKJV)

“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.” (Hebrews 11:1 NKJV)

“For we walk by faith, not by sight.” (2 Corinthians 5:7 NKJV)

- Christian mothers realize that they hold to God’s hand and allow Him to lead the family.

II. Moma’s power came through her faith in God.

“So Jesus said to them, ‘Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, “Move from here to there,” and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.’” (Matthew 17:20 NKJV)

“Jesus said to him, ‘If you can believe, all things *are possible to him who believes.*’” (Mark 9:23 NKJV)

- Christian mothers’ strength comes from knowing that God is going to help them.

III. Moma created a legacy of faith.

“When I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also.” (2 Timothy 1:5 NKJV)

“‘Therefore I also have lent him to the LORD; as long as he lives he shall be lent to the LORD.’ So they worshiped the LORD there.” (1 Samuel 1:28 NKJV)

- Children should see their mother living out her faith and teaching it to them.
