Acts 1:8

I. S _ _ _ _ _ POWER

Acts 4:7 – And when they had placed them in the center, they began to inquire, “By what power, or in what name, have you done this?”

Acts 9:6 – but rise, and enter the city, and it shall be told you what you must do.”

II. S _ _ _ _ _ POWER

Acts 4:13 – Now as they observed the confidence of Peter and John, and understood that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were marveling, and began to recognize them as having been with Jesus.

Acts 7:55, 58, 60 – ⁵⁵ But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, gazed steadily upward into heaven and saw the glory of God, and he saw Jesus standing in the place of honor at God’s right hand... ⁵⁸ They dragged him out of the city and began to stone him. The official witnesses took off their coats and laid them at the feet of a young man named Saul... ⁶⁰ And he fell to his knees, shouting, “Lord, don’t charge them with this sin!” And with that, he died.

III. S _ _ _ _ _ POWER

Acts 2:45 – and they began selling their property and possessions, and were sharing them with all, as anyone might have need.

Acts 4:34, 35 – For there was not a needy person among them, for all who were owners of land or houses would sell them and bring the proceeds of the sales, and lay them at the apostles’ feet; and they would be distributed to each, as any had need.
