



Pressing My Way Through

Mark 5:23-34

1. Have a determined attitude.

Mark 5:25-27, 31 “Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for 12 years, and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse. When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. . . But His disciples said to Him, “You see the multitude thronging You, and You say, “Who touched Me?”” (NKJV)

Philippians 3:13 “Brethren, I do not regard myself as having laid hold of it yet; but one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and reaching forward to what lies ahead,” (NASB)

2. We must press our way with faith.

Mark 5:31, 34 “But His disciples said to Him, ‘You see the multitude thronging You, and You say, “Who touched Me?”’ . . . And He said to her, ‘Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction.’” (NKJV)

Your faith is worth more than precious gold, and when we come through (and we will come through), we will bring praise and honor and glory to God.

1 John 5:4 “For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith.” (NKJV)

Just an ordinary touch. This woman had touched in faith. I want you to know today that faith makes the difference and we must press our way with Faith!

3. Jesus will look for our faithfulness.

Mark 5:30 “And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, ‘Who touched My clothes?’” (NKJV)
